2019 Lawrence County Fair 4-H & FFA Market Livestock Announcements

- **Exhibition of Multiple Species**

4-H & FFA Members **are eligible to exhibit up to** two large market species and one pen of market rabbits or market chickens. With the exception, member may not exhibit more than one market steer.

Examples could be as follows:

1. 2 market goats or 2 market lambs or 2 market hogs and 1 pen of mkt rabbits or mkt chickens
2. 1 market steer and 1 hog or 1 lamb or 1 goat and 1 pen of rabbits or chickens
3. 1 of 1 large specie and another 1 of 1 large specie and 1 pen of rabbits or chickens

Per ODA all Champions/Reserve Champions must sell, if an exhibitor wins more than one grand and/or reserve then all will sell. Exhibitor will receive all the proceeds of one champion/reserve, market value plus 50% of overage of 2nd champion/reserve, and market value plus 25% of overage for the third. The remainder goes into a scholarship fund to be used the following year.

*Non-champion sale remains the same, one time through the sale ring per exhibitor all others drop slipped or sent to market.

** Multiple species exhibition is not required.

- **2019 Lawrence County Fair Tag-In Dates**

All 4-H and FFA members must be enrolled in a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter by *March 15th, 2019*. Enrollment Records must indicate the project(s) the youth wishes to exhibit. In order to show and sale at the Lawrence County Fair, all market animals must be tagged or tattooed on the designated tag-in date. No projects can be corrected after the March 31st enrollment correction date.

8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.
Must be born on or after December 1, 2018

GOATS

Saturday, April 27, 2019, Lawrence County Fairgrounds
8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.
Must be born on or after December 1, 2018

MARKET FEEDER STEER AND HEIFER

Saturday, June 8, 2018, Lawrence County Fairgrounds
8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
Must be born between Jan. 1, 2019 and April 30, 2019

RABBITS

Saturday, June 8, 2019, Lawrence County Fairgrounds
7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
***Born by date should be discussed with your breeder in order to weigh 4.5 – 5.5lbs by weigh-in at county fair.*

CHICKENS

Market chicken orders must be received at the Extension Office, no later than March 15th.
Price & Pick up date will be announced at a later date.

- **4-H Volunteer Background Check Rescreening**
Letters from Ohio 4-H have been sent to the volunteers needing rescreened for the 2019 year. If it is your year to be rescreened, please **complete between October 1 – December 31, 2018** to remain a 4-H volunteer. After October 1, please re-enroll using the oh.4honline.com system or submit your reimbursement form to the Extension Office immediately following completion of BCI check, so your report can be found by the state office easily.
 - **4-H Online Enrollment**
4-H online enrollment will open October 1st for the 2018 -2019 year. The website to enroll is oh.4honline.com, using your enrollment e-mail from 2018 families can enroll using their enrollment e-mail address from last year & new members can set up a new account.
