

County-Wide Quality Assurance Options

Quality Assurance (QA) is required by all livestock exhibitors. It must be complete by May 1 to be eligible to show and sell at the Lawrence County Fair.

County-wide In-Person Options include:

- **March 7th:** Lawrence County Extension Office, 6:30pm or 7:30pm
 - 20 seats available at each time.
- **March 26th:** Symmes Valley High School, 4:30, 5:30 or 6:30pm
 - ****Test Out** will also be available this date for 12 and up (4-H age).
- **March 28th:** Lawrence County Extension Office, 5:30pm, 6:30pm or 7:30pm
 - 20 seats available at each time.

Registration is required 48 hrs prior to date you are scheduling, please visit:

QA Test-Out: Exhibitors, 12 years and older (4-H age), are eligible to test out. 12 – 14-year-olds who test out, must re-test at 4-H age 15. Exhibitors 15-18 years old do not need to retest once passed. If you can not attend the Symmes Valley date, please contact our office to schedule an appointment.

Lawrence County is also accepting YCQAprogram.org as a completion option:

1. Be sure you are enrolled in 4-Honline for the current 4-H year.
2. Register for the online course to complete on your own pace at YCQAprogram.org for your 4-H age Quality Assurance Age Option. Cost is \$12.00.
3. Complete the course by May 1 and send a copy of your certificate of completion to Fraley.171@osu.edu
